Objectives:

- To encourage an understanding of the broad geographical and social scope of the history of the Christian church, its major turning points, personalities, and teachings.

 - 1) Four page history and doctrine of denomination and handout filled out and bibliography.
 - 2) A multi-media assignment. See portal
 - 3) 2 visits to service at a church of your religious denomination. Following this -3 page paper following site visit instructions found on portal.
 - 4) *Upper Division* Interviews with two members of the denomination one must be a professional (priest, minister, deacon etc) and another may be a lay person. Further instructions on portal.
 - 5) A 15 minute group oral presentation. See syllabus for date of your presentation. Prior to this presentation you must meet with professor during office hours.
 - 6) *Upper Division* A final, thesis driven, 8 to 10 page research paper based on the accumulated evidence.
