- Sociology of religion and the legacy and potential of the University of California, Berkeley, Sociology Department (e.g., Bellah, Goffman, Glock, Stark, Wuthnow, Swidler, Wacquant, Jay, etc.)
- Civil religion today
- The “unsung heroes” of sociology of religion (e.g., Simmel, Elias, Luhmann, Etzioni, etc.)
- Religious and social change in the Mediterranean

This Consultation provides a forum for the discussion of empirical and theoretical research on religion and society. “Sociology” is broadly conceived; discussions will include different epistemologies, varying theoretical backgrounds, qualitative and quantitative methodologies, and a wide range of empirical data. By liaising with other Program Units, we seek to provide a platform for research that empirically and theoretically engages the question of the role of religion in societies globally.
